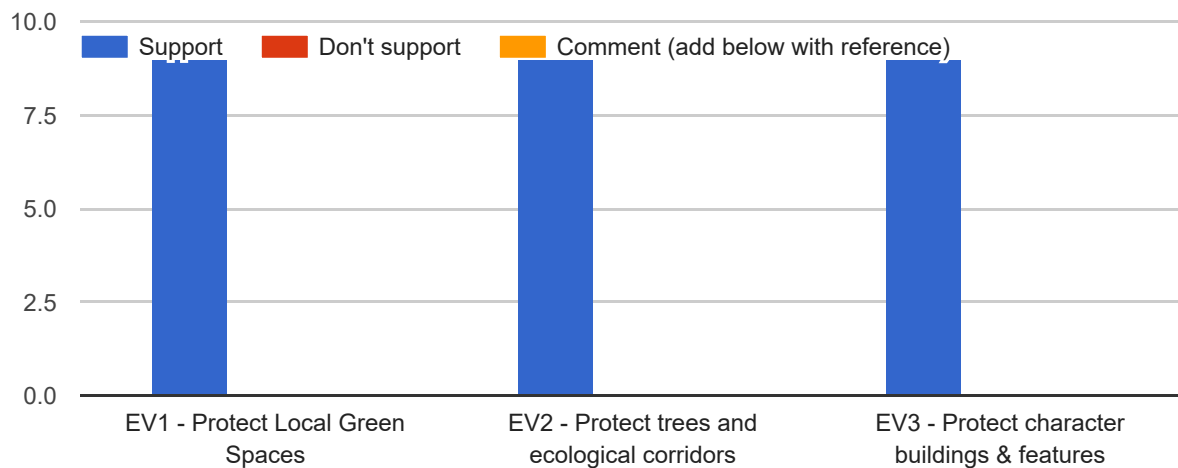
There may be small parcels of land in the village outside the current defined development boundary which can sympathetically be developed in line with the objectives set out in the policies

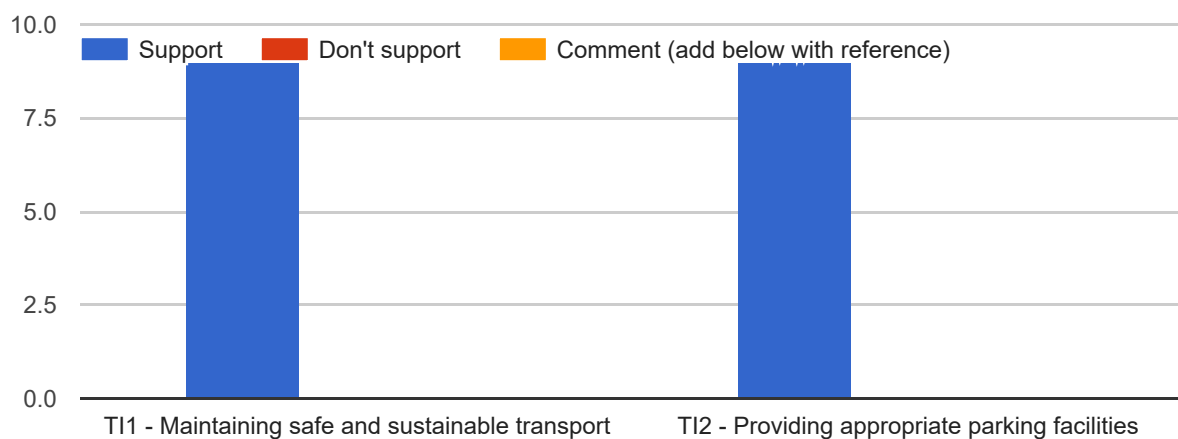

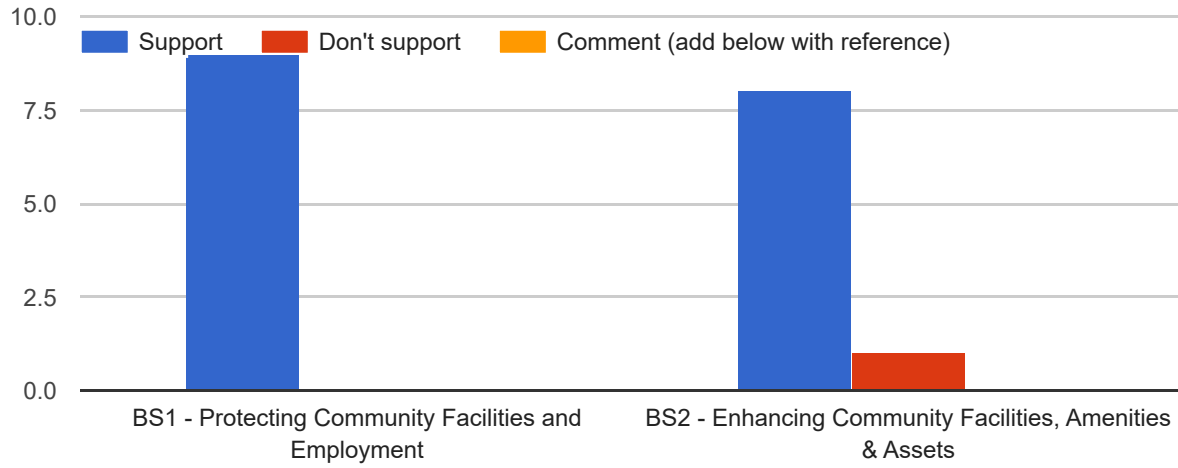

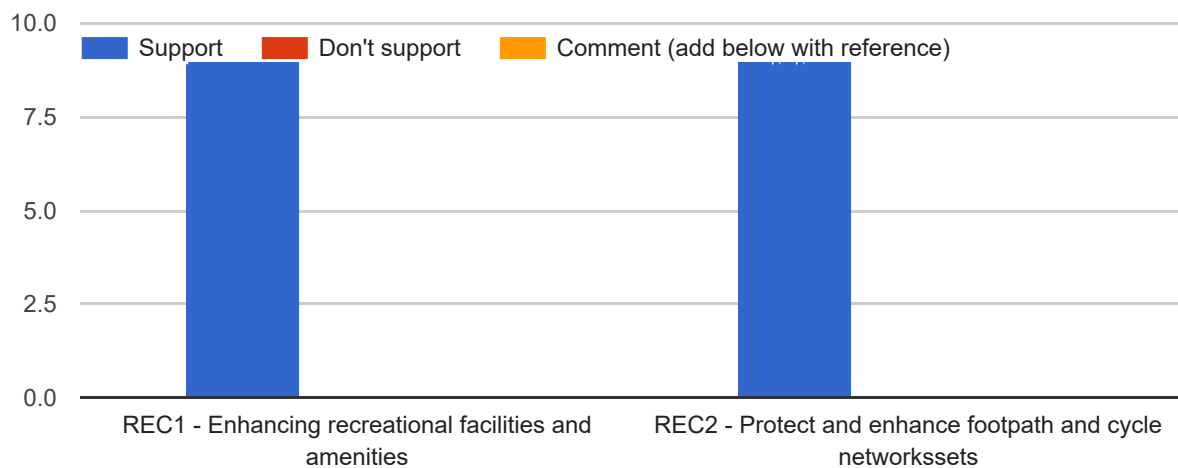
